### About the project

The NIK project started in October 2019. BioComp aims to describe and prioritize specific skills/competences in the Biobased economy (BBE) and to develop an on-line tool, based on Learning Scenarios to create personalized training programs for VET students and workers in the circular economy. Partners are from Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Greece, the Netherlands, and Romania. The project focus on four learning scenarios:

- Production of Algae,
- Biogas,
- Cereals for bio-packaging,
- Setting up a BBE company.
