## Motivation for volunteering and to help to solve crises in V4 countries

Note:

### **Survey on volunteering and charitable giving in V4 countries connected with unexpected events**

Data collection took place as part of a survey focused on volunteering and donation in V4 countries associated with sudden events and crises. The data were collected in V4 countries, i.e. in the Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland and Slovakia. The survey was conducted by the SC & C (survey agency) in collaboration with survey agencies in other countries.

This is the English version of the survey; the survey was conducted in the national languages – Czech, Polish, Hungarian and Slovak. When translating the answers to the questions marked in red, they were localized to the specifics of the given country, e.g. the amount of donations, local events, regions etc.

Data collection took place in all countries using a combination of CAWI (Computer Assisted Web Interviewing) and CATI (Computer Assisted Telephone Interviewing) methods. The data are representative of the 18+ population of each participating country (representativeness was ensured by applying socio-demographic quotas for gender, age, education and type of housing).
